PART 1901 - PROGRAM RELATED INSTRUCTIONS

SUBPART F - PROCEDURES FOR THE PROTECTION OF
HISTORICAL AND ARCHEOLOGICAL PROPERTIES

SECTION 1901.251 Purpose

This subpart supplements instruction 1901-F and provides direction on how to access a list of all districts, sites, building, structures and objects, significant in American history, architecture, archeology and culture in Missouri, which are to be protected. These properties are monitored or maintained by the Secretary of the Interior and are included on the National Register of Historic Places.

SECTION 1901.254 Scope

This subpart is applicable to any undertaking listed in 1901.254 (a) financed in whole or in part by Rural Development loans, grants or guarantees.

SECTION 1901.255 Historical and Archeological Assessments

The Rural Development official who completes the environmental review in accordance with FmHA Instruction 1940-G is responsible for the actions required in section 1901.255 (a) of the national instruction.
