

PART 1901 - PROGRAM RELATED INSTRUCTIONS

SUBPART F - PROCEDURES FOR THE PROTECTION OF HISTORICAL AND
ARCHEOLOGICAL PROPERTIES

1901.251 – Purpose

This instruction supplements RD Instruction 1901-F.

This instruction establishes the policies and procedures to be followed by Rural Development to comply with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (Public Law 89-665), the Reservoir Salvage Act of 1960 (Public Law 86-523), as amended May 24, 1974, by the Archeologic and Historic Preservation Act (Public Law 93-291), and Section 1(3) of Executive Order 11593.

1901.255 – Historical and archeological assessments.

All dwellings that are 50 years or older, must be submitted to the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) for historical and archeological review.

The “PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT, RURAL HOUSING SERVICE (RHS), THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION (ACHP), AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER (SHPO) REGARDING FEDERAL RURAL HOUSING FINANCING AND REHABILITATION PROGRAMS”, Exhibit A, specifically provides guidance in the execution and implementation of this requirement. The Programmatic Agreement is to be followed to determine if a loan, loan guarantee or grant proposal will need to be submitted to the SHPO for review.
