## City of Keyser Approved For Rural Development Funding

**Morgantown, WV – September 1, 2011:** State Director Bobby Lewis today announced that **USDA Rural Development** approved a Water and Waste Disposal Loan of \$2,642,000 for the City of Keyser, Mineral County, WV.

Rural Development funds will be used to replace existing sewer lines that are in extremely poor condition and do not provide adequate levels of storm water drainage or sanitary sewer drainage. This project is needed to prevent wastewater back-up into yards and homes. Approximately 68 customers within the Chestnut Street area of Keyser will benefit from this project.

Rural Development serves as the lead Federal entity for rural development needs and administers program assistance through its housing, business, community and infrastructure programs.
