Mock's Greenhouse and Landscaping Approved For Energy Grant

Morgantown, WV – July 7, 2010: State Director **Bobby Lewis** announces that **Rural Development** approved a Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) Grant in the amount of \$19,140 for Mock's Greenhouse and Landscaping, Morgan County, WV.

Rural Development funds, leveraged with other funding sources, will be used to install a renewable energy system for greenhouse operations. The renewable energy technologies to be utilized include photovoltaic and geothermal systems for electricity and heating.

Rural Development serves as the lead Federal entity for rural development needs and administers program assistance through its housing, business/cooperative, community and infrastructure programs.
