Putnam PSD Approved For Water and Waste Loan

Morgantown, WV – March 31, 2011: State Director Bobby Lewis announces that **Rural Development** approved a Water and Waste Disposal Loan in the amount of \$564,800 for Putnam Public Service District, Putnam County, WV.

Rural Development funds will be used to assist in the construction of a new sanitary sewer collection system for several areas within Putnam County, West Virginia. The project also includes the replacement of aging and deteriorated sewer collection lines.

Lewis added, “Extensions will include the addition of approximately 448 customers in the areas of Route 33, Rocky Step Road, and Route 60 within Putnam County. Line replacement will take place within Marina Park.”

This funding is an additional loan to finance additions that were included to the project during final design. An initial loan of \$12,930,000 was obligated on September 30, 2010.

Rural Development serves as the lead Federal entity for rural development needs and administers program assistance through its housing, business/cooperative, community and infrastructure programs.
