Temporary Construction Sign Design Requirements for Projects Funded  
by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Housing Service and Rural  
Business-Cooperative Service

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Architectural Technical Guide (ATG) is to provide a general design guidance for the temporary project construction sign to be provided for construction projects funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Housing Service and Rural Business-Cooperative Service. This design concept is intended to disseminate key information regarding the development team (project owner, architect, contractor, funding agencies, other lenders, and other interested parties) as well as Equal Housing Opportunity to the general public. The sign's construction would utilize a conventional 4'x8' plywood back panel and other conventional construction materials and methods.

**IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The attached design should be used as the basis for the temporary project construction sign for all construction projects funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Housing Service and Rural Business-Cooperative Service. The sign should be installed at a prominent location on the property oriented to the general public.

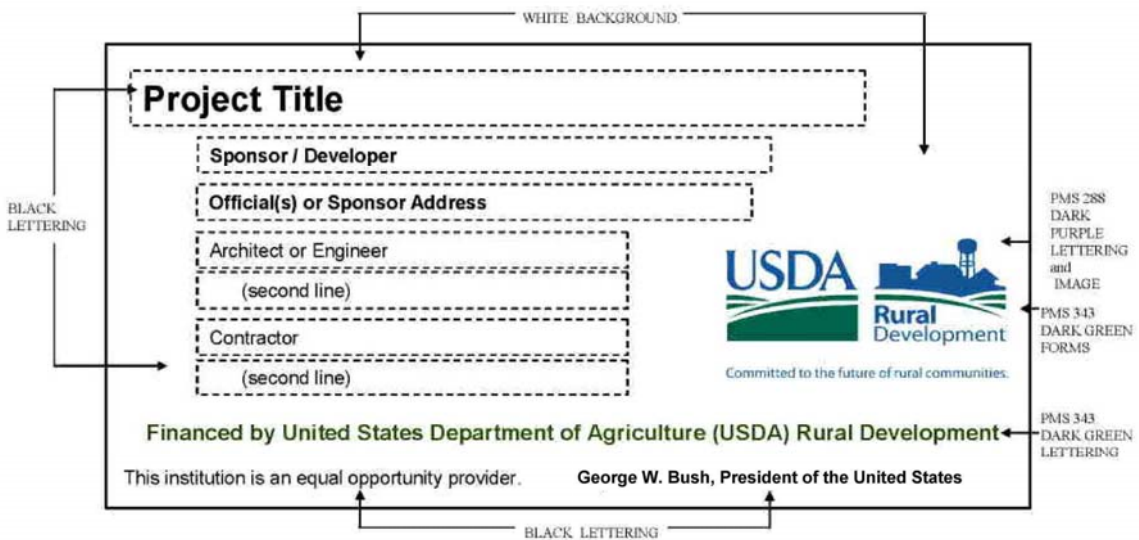
