

2002 FARM BILL PROJECTS

CORINNA SEWER DISTRICT

Upgrading wastewater treatment facility.

MADISON WATER DISTRICT

System upgrade to meet safe drinking water requirements. This project will eliminate the areas that do not meet chlorine residuals.

NEW PORTLAND WATER DISTRICT (ECWAG)

The district has had a water consumption advisory for over a year. This project will correct an acute water shortage.

NEWPORT WATER DISTRICT

This project will correct design deficiencies that allowed untreated water to flood the chemical and instrumentation rooms.

NORTHPORT VILLAGE COPORATION

Improvements to public water distribution to address arsenic contamination of private wells.

TOWN OF VINALHAVEN

This is Phase II of the wastewater collection and treatment project. It is necessary to meet health and sanitary standards as determined by the DEP.

2002 RURAL UTILITIES OBLIGATIONS

ALFRED WATER DISTRICT

This project is to install new equipment and a new building to help alleviate a dangerously low water supply that has the system in crisis.

TOWN OF BENTON

This project will install transfer lines, booster station upgrades, and other improvements in conjunction with the DOT removal and moving of bridges between Fairfield and Benton.

BRIDGTON WATER DISTRICT

This project will replace the reservoir and install transmission lines.

CITY OF GARDINER

This project will upgrade the current wastewater system, correct current defects, and construct a new Combined Sewer Overflow structure.

HOULTON WATER COMPANY

This project will replace approximately 3,000 feet of sewer lines. These lines are currently a potential source of contamination to a local brook.

MAPLETON SEWER DISTRICT

This project will construct a wastewater lagoon to correct oxygen discharge into the Presque Isle Stream.

MILO WATER DISTRICT

This project will replace approximately 5,000 feet of sewer mains to meet state drinking water standards.

TOWN OF MILFORD

This project will upgrade the treatment plant and eliminate two sewer outflows into the Penobscot River.

MOSCOW WATER DISTRICT

This project is for pump station upgrades.

TOWN OF NORTH HAVEN

This project will construct a new pre-ozonation and slow-sand filtration plant to meet the Surface Water Treatment Rule of the Safe Drinking Water Act.

NORTHPORT VILLAGE CORPORATION

The first project will upgrade the sewer and stormwater distribution system. The second project will upgrade the replace the water main.

CITY OF OLD TOWN

This project will upgrade the mechanical treatment plant and provide stormwater separation to minimize sewage discharges to the Penobscot River.

TOWN OF ORRINGTON

This project will be for a sewer utilities extension into an area that has no public water supply or wastewater treatment facility.

PENOBSCOT NATION

This project will complete upgrades to a sewerage pump station.

PASSAMAQUODDY TRIBE PLEASANT POINT

This project will improve the sewer treatment plant and increase the concentration of sludge produced by the plant.

TOWN OF SOUTHWEST HARBOR

This project will replace sewer lines and add a sewer line extension and a new pump station as recommended by the DEP.

TOWN OF VINALHAVEN

This project is for a new wastewater collection and treatment system.
