

Missouri Instruction 1940-G

PART 1940 - GENERAL

SUBPART G - ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAM

SECTION 1940.301 Purpose

This subpart supplements FmHA/Rural Development instruction 1901-G and contains the Missouri Natural Resource Management Guide. The Guide is a reference to be used by applicants in preparing Form FmHA 1940-20, Request for Environmental Information. It should also be used by Rural Development officials in processing the environmental reviews and assessments for proposed loan and/or grant actions.

SECTION 1940.302 Definitions

(i) Preparer of environmental review documents. Completion of environmental review and assessment documents can best be accomplished by Rural Development staff members located in the office in which the action is initiated. Accordingly, authority is hereby delegated to incumbents of the positions of Assistant to the State Director, Rural Development Manager, Rural Development Specialist, Rural Development Technician, Community Development Manager, Community Development Specialist, Community Development Technician, Rural Housing Program Director, Rural Housing Specialist, Community and Business Programs Director, Community and Business Programs Specialist, State Engineer, Appraiser, and State Architect/Construction Analyst to complete environmental reviews and assessments within the authorities prescribed by FmHA/Rural Development instructions. These delegations will remain in effect until restricted or revoked in writing.
