

PART 1940 – GENERAL

SUBPART J – INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVIEW OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

SECTION 1940.451 Purpose

This subpart supplements Rural Development Instruction 1940-J, Intergovernmental Review of Rural Development Programs and Activities and identifies the State's single point of contact, as well as the regional planning commissions.

SECTION 1940.455 Intergovernmental consultation system for programs a State has elected to review.

All applicants for financial assistance of the type listed in Section 1940.453(a) of Rural Development Instruction 1940-J will file written notification of its intent to apply for such assistance with the State using Form AD-621. The State has elected not to review the following requests for assistance: Rural Rental Housing loans involving fewer than 25 apartments, Soil and Water loans, Site Development Work (subdivision development) involving fewer than 25 lots, and Fire and Rescue loans and grants under the Community Facility program. In Missouri, the State desires that written notification also be provided to the respective area's regional planning commission at the same time it is sent to the State's single point of contact. If the regional planning commission desires to make comments, they will be attached to the State comments to the applicant. Copies of the State clearinghouse comments, with attachments, must accompany the preapplication when it is forwarded to the State Office.
