CITY OF WILDWOOD RECEIVES FEDERAL FUNDS FROM USDA PROGRAMS

CITY OF WILDWOOD, NJ – SEPTEMBER 17, 2004 - “The United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development is pleased to make available \$75,000 in Federal funds through a Memorandum of Understanding for the City of Wildwood to study parking improvements for visitors to the City. These funds are necessary to continue the revitalization efforts by the current City Administration and is the result of the partnership of leaders from the City, County, and the South Jersey Economic Development District, said Andrew Law, State Director for USDA Rural Development.”

Two ceremonial checks are being presented to the City of Wildwood Mayor Ernie Troiano. Both projects are funded through the Community Facilities Grant Program First Responder Initiative. \$350,000 will be used to construct emergency vehicle access to the City of Wildwood boardwalk. The additional \$181,500 will be used to provide for an Emergency Operations Center, new communications equipment for police and firefighters and replace the on site emergency generator at City Hall.
