

RURAL AREAS

Definition of Rural Area:

Rural areas include open country and communities with populations of not more than 10,000, which are rural in character and not closely associated with urban areas. Under certain conditions, Rural Development is permitted to make housing loans in place of up to 20,000 in population, which are not contained within a metropolitan statistical area.

Maps delineating eligible rural area boundaries are available in the administrative office in Portland or the branch office serving the county in which the property is located. See Oregon Directory of RD offices.
