◆ OBJECTIVE

- ◆ Farm Labor Housing loans provide farm labor housing in either dormitory, single family, or multi-family apartment style.

◆ ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- ◆ Farm Owners
- ◆ Family Farm Partnerships
- ◆ Family Farm Corporations
- ◆ Farming Associations
- ◆ Non-Profit Organizations and Limited Partnerships

◆ ELIGIBLE PROPERTIES

- ◆ "On-Farm" Provides housing for domestic farm laborers employed by the farm borrowers.
- ◆ "Off-Farm" Provides housing for domestic farm laborers employed by numerous farm entities.

◆ ELIGIBLE FARM LABORERS/TENANTS

- ◆ Must be domestic farm laborers
- ◆ United States citizens or legal aliens, permanently admitted to the United States (No H2A, H2B, etc.)

◆ RATES AND TERMS

- ◆ Rate: 1 percent
- ◆ Loan terms of up to 33 years
- ◆ Rental Assistance may be available to eligible off farm applicants

◆ FEES

- ◆ Credit Report: \$28 for individual; \$40 for corporations
