

Secretary of Agriculture Visits Louisa Virginia



On the 200th day since President Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act into law, Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack, high lighted the important investments being made in rural communities throughout the country and in Louisa, Virginia.

On September 3, 2009, Secretary Vilsack visited the Louisa County Administration Building to make the national announcement that over \$27 billion dollars of Stimulus Assistance has been provided by USDA.

He also congratulated the Town and County of Louisa for their recent Rural Development Stimulus Funding in the amount of \$3.3 million. This assistance will be used to upgrade the aging wastewater treatment plant in the community and will help create jobs in the area.
