NON-RURAL AREA DESIGNATION

I. GENERAL: This instruction supplements, but does not supersede Chapter 5 of Handbook-1-3550.

II. CHAPTER 5, Section 1: 5.3 C, 3, Notification of Determination.

This state instruction identifies ineligible (non-rural) areas of Washington State, specifically; ineligible towns or places in Washington that are part of or associated with an ineligible urban area which require maps with boundary lines separating rural and non-rural areas.

III. IDENTIFICATION OF NON-RURAL AREAS: Per HB-1-3550, the areas listed below are considered ineligible for rural housing programs. The ineligible areas are identified on maps clearly defining the boundary lines between rural and urban areas. The maps are shown as Exhibits A-R of this instruction. The maps for the particular areas served by each local office are to be posted in a conspicuous place in each Local Office. Included with each map is a written description of the boundary lines. The written descriptions are shown as Exhibits A-1 thru R-1.
