## Ravencliff-McGraws-Saulsville PSD Approved For Federal Grant

**Morgantown, WV – February 4, 2009:** Acting State Director Dianne Goff Crysler announces that **Rural Development** approved a Water and Waste Disposal Grant of \$350,000 for Ravencliff-McGraws-Saulsville Public Service District, Wyoming County, WV.

Rural Development funds will be used to extend public water service to approximately 124 new customers in the Jesse and Trough Fork areas of Wyoming County, West Virginia. The Matheny Public Service District will also merge with the Ravencliff-McGraws-Saulsville PSD, transferring another 190 customers to Ravencliff.

This is subsequent funding to cover a construction bid over-run. A Rural Development loan of \$1,114,000 and grant of \$1,750,000 were obligated in August 2002.

Rural Development serves as the lead Federal entity for rural development needs and administers program assistance through its housing, business/cooperative, community and infrastructure programs.
